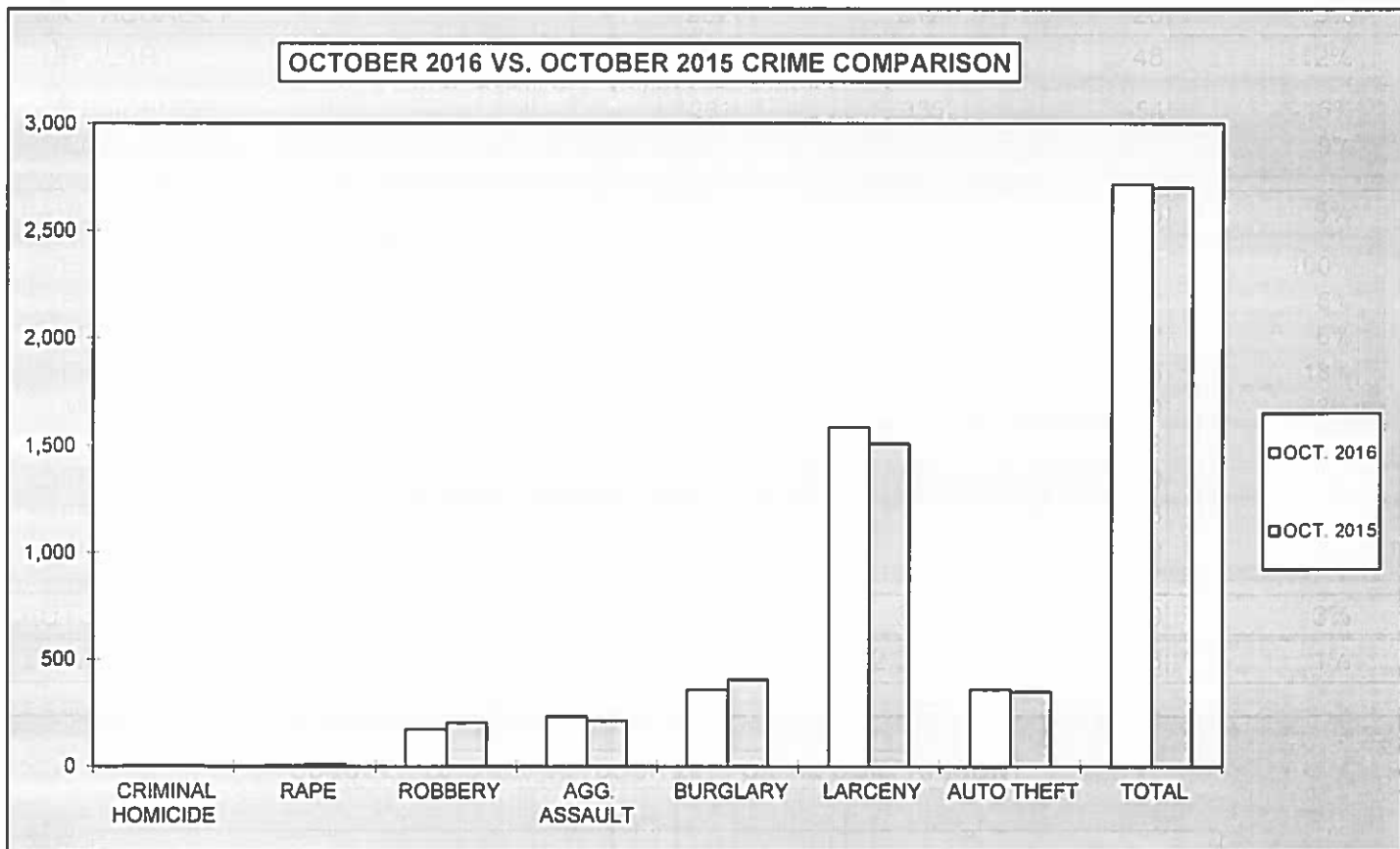
**HOMICIDE BREAKDOWN BY VICTIM/OFFENDER RELATIONSHIP**

**ATLANTA AIRPORT YEAR TO DATE CRIME COMPARISON**

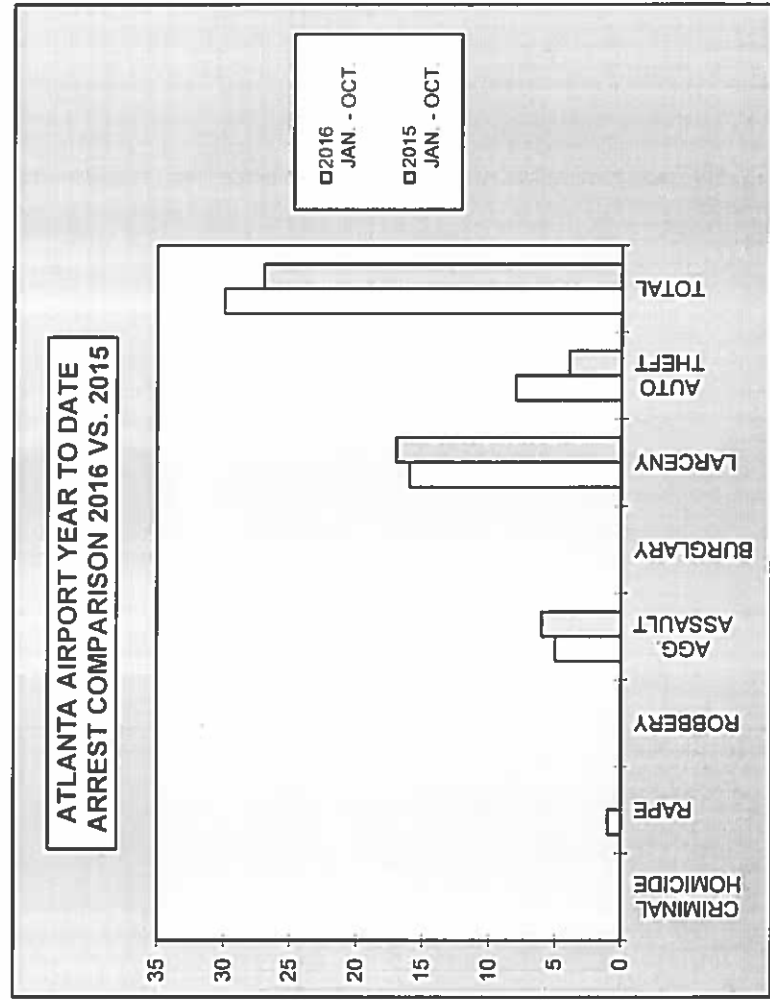
