Application for Vehicle for Hire Certificate of Public Necessity and Convenience (CPNC) Renewal Instruction Sheet

Type or print neatly.

All questions must be answered completely. <u>Do not leave blanks: note N/A if not applicable</u>. Also, note that no incomplete application shall be accepted. Application must be completed, signed, and notarized.

Submit as attachment #1: a letter from the vehicle for hire company under which the CPNC will be operating.

Submit as attachment #2: proof that the applicant has the right to work in the United States. **Acceptable Documents:** Birth Certificate, Certificate of Naturalization, Permanent Resident Card, Employee Authorization Document

Submit as attachment #3: notarized Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlement (SAVE) Program Affidavit

Submit as attachment #4: If operating as a corporation, certified copy of articles of incorporation by the Georgia Secretary of State, and the name(s) and position(s) of all officers.

FINGERPRINTS, BACKGROUND CHECKS, AND PHOTOGRAPHS ARE REQUIRED FOR EACH APPLICANT.

You are encouraged to familiarize yourself with Atlanta City Code Chapter 162
A copy may be obtained from the Division of Taxicabs and Vehicles for Hire, the Municipal Clerk's Office (404-330-6032), or online at www.municode.com. Please govern yourself accordingly.

NOTICE: An applicant shall not be eligible for a CPNC if he/she/it does <u>not</u> meet or maintain the following requirements:

- (1) Be at least 18 years of age.
- (2) Be a citizen of the United States or an alien admitted for permanent residence or otherwise granted employment authorization by the United States Immigration and Naturalization Service.
- (3) Not have been convicted of any felony if such violation is related to the operation of a motor vehicle or with operation of a vehicle for hire and not have been convicted of violating any section of Atlanta City Code Chapter 162 or other ordinance of the city governing the conduct of CPNC holders; provided, however, that all such persons shall be entitled to the full benefits of O.C.G.A tit. 23, ch. 8, art.3 (O.C.G.A. § 42-8-60 et seq.), the First Offender Act and be considered as provided in Atlanta City Code Section 30-29.

**Should the applicant for a CPNC be a corporation or partnership, the chief executive officer of the corporation or, if a partnership, the partner with the greatest proprietary interest shall possess all of the requirements outlined above.

- (4) Within ten (10) days of any of the following, the CPNC holder shall so notify the bureau in writing:
 - a. Change in the chief executive officer, if a corporation, and the notification shall set out the names of the persons involved in the change.
 - b. Change in the CPNC holder of 50 percent or more of the proprietary interest, if a partnership, corporation, firm or association, and the notification shall set our the names of the persons involved in the change.
 - c. Change of address of the CPNC holder.

- (5) Each CPNC holder of the taxicabs classification shall be affiliated with a taxicab company, except when the CPNC holder is a taxicab company. The CPNC holder shall notify the bureau of any change in the holder's company affiliation within three (3) days of any such change on a form provided by the Bureau.
- (6) The CPNC holder shall apply for and obtain an <u>annual renewal</u> of the CPNC upon payment of a fee of \$100.00 and provision of evidence that the holder continues to possess the necessary qualifications for holding a CPNC. <u>This fee shall be paid by</u> the last day of the month in which the CPNC was initially issued.

Transferability

- (1) No voluntary transfer or sale of a CPNC may be made if a judgment has been filed with the bureau against the holder of a CPNC and remains unsatisfied and notice of said judgment has been filed with the bureau, except that a transfer may be permitted if an appeal is pending from an unsatisfied judgment and a bond is filed in an amount sufficient to satisfy the judgment but not to exceed the fair market value of the CPNC or CPNC's being transferred. Transfer may also be permitted without filing a bond, provided that all the judgment creditors of unsatisfied judgments file written permission for such a transfer with the bureau.
- (2) The transferee shall supply proof to the bureau that he or his transferor has filed a bond to cover all of the outstanding tort liabilities of the transferor in excess of the amount covered by a bond or insurance policy in effect at the time the claim arose; however, this requirement shall not apply to a legatee or distributor of a descendant's estate owning a CPNC.
- (3) An owner's interest in a CPNC may be transferred involuntarily and disposed of by public or private sale in the same manner as personal property. However, upon such involuntary transfer, the owner's CPNC shall immediately be canceled and a new CPNC issued to the transferee, except that if the involuntary transfer is by reason of a tort judgment against an involuntary transferor, no bond need by provided with respect to the same judgment.

- (4) All open items, including summons, outstanding fines and penalties against the CPNC must be cleared before a transfer will be approved. When the transferor is a corporation and there are two or more CPNC's with open items against them, all CPNC's must be cleared in order to transfer one CPNC.
- (5) A CPNC may not be transferred during a period of suspension.
- (6) In the event of the death of any person holding a CPNC, the CPNC may be transferred by the chief to the administrator, executor, or any lawful heir of the deceased person if the transferee meets all requirements for obtaining a CPNC. The CPNC shall be automatically suspended upon the death of the CPNC holder pending the transfer. If no application for a transfer has been filed within 90 days from actual notice to the transferee of the death of the CPNC holder, the CPNC shall automatically expire. When a CPNC or stock in a corporation owning a CPNC is distributed from an estate to a legatee or distributee, the following documents shall be submitted with the transfer application:
 - 1. A certified copy of the relevant death certificate;
 - A certified copy of letters testamentary or letter of administration;
 - 3. A copy of the will, if any, certified by the attorney for the estate.
- (7) Nothing in Atlanta City Code Section 162-62 shall prohibit the transfer of a security interest in a CPNC from its owner to a financial or lending institution or corporation or individual so that such CPNC may be used as collateral for a loan. Notice of the use of any CPNC as collateral for a loan must be provided by the person to whom the CPNC has been issued within five (5) days to the bureau on a form provided by the bureau.

<u>Financial Interest</u> - An interest equated with money or its equivalent. Any person having a monetary interest in the CPNC must be disclosed. Example: A person who owns shares in the CPNC or any part of the CPNC or is in the process of buying the CPNC has a financial interest.

<u>Beneficial Interest</u> - Any person who derives a profit, benefit or advantage resulting from a contract or agreement with the CPNC holder. This would include any person who benefits in some way through the CPNC holder.

<u>Legal Interest</u> - This includes, among other things, an interest arising out of a contract. Any person who has entered into a contract relating to the purchase of the CPNC (conditional sale) has a legal interest in the CPNC.

Equitable Interest - This includes, among other things, a beneficiary in case of a CPNC holder's death or divorce. Spouses or other designated beneficiaries have an equitable interest in the license.
