NARRATIVE

On June 19, 2022 at approximately 2349 hours I, Officer D. Long (unit 1202 body cam # X6033345M), was dispatched to 526 King Road in reference to a burglary call.

Once responding units and I arrived on scene we saw a large amount of \$100 bills spilled on the ground outside of the gated home. We also located a gold Desert Eagle firearm still in it's gun case and a black Glock 26 with an extended mag located on the ground outside of

the gated home as well. we later found that the Desert Eagle belonged to the homeowner and the Glock 26 is suspected to be the suspect's firearm. The suspect's firearm was ran over ACIC but came back with no records found.

Upon gaining entry into the gates of the home we noticed that a 1st level window to the front of the home was completely broken in. Once inside of the home I made contact with the victim, Ms. Sondi CARTER, who stated she was laying in bed with her two sons when she heard loud noises coming from the front of her home. Ms. CARTER stated that she took her sons and hid in their bedroom closet as she heard the unknown suspects gain entry into her home. According to Ms. Carter, she called 911 while in the closet and sent a text to the neighbor patrol, 6509X Officer Feelings, while on the phone with dispatch. Ms. Carter stated she could hear the unknown suspects come upstairs and rummage through their belongings in different rooms while she hid. Multiple rooms were in disarray and the gate for the top of the stairs was broken off of its hinges.

Supervisor unit 1295 Sgt. Strickland was notified and responded to the scene. G.I unit 4162 Inv. McManis and I.D unit 7317 H. Brown were raised and responded to the scene as well. The scene was processed for prints and a print was able to be lifted from a side door near the back gate that the suspect may have used to flee the home. The money on the ground outside of the home was counted to be \$16,100 and was returned to the victim, Ms. Carter. Ms. Carter's husband (who I spoke to over the phone) stated that the \$16,100 recovered was just a small portion of over \$100,000 that was missing from a brown bag he had in the master bedroom closet. Mr. Carter advised that the Desert Eagle was taken from the master bedroom closet as well. ID collected the suspect's Glock 26 and took pictures of the crime scene.

Vic was raised by an assisting officer and advised that the black SUV that fled the scene was last seen at Northside Drive and Blackland at approximately 2353 hours. Vic was unable to provide a make, model or tag number for the vehicle. Ms. Carter did have cameras on the property but advised they did not cover the street area outside of the gated home. A copy of the surveillance video was submitted to the G.I unit by Ms. Carter.

Ms. Carter was given a case # for the incident. Nothing further at this time.
