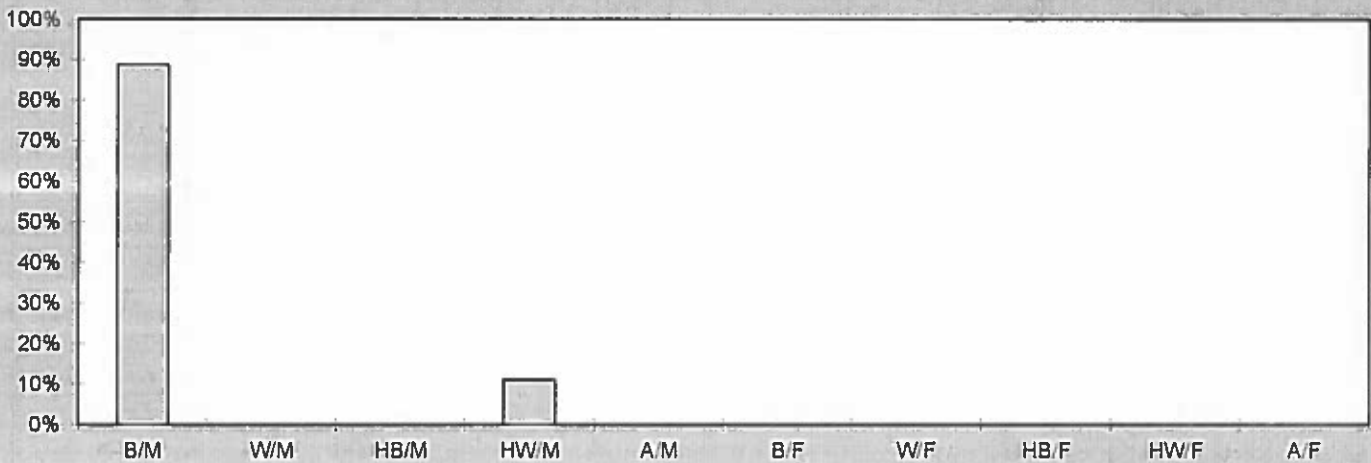

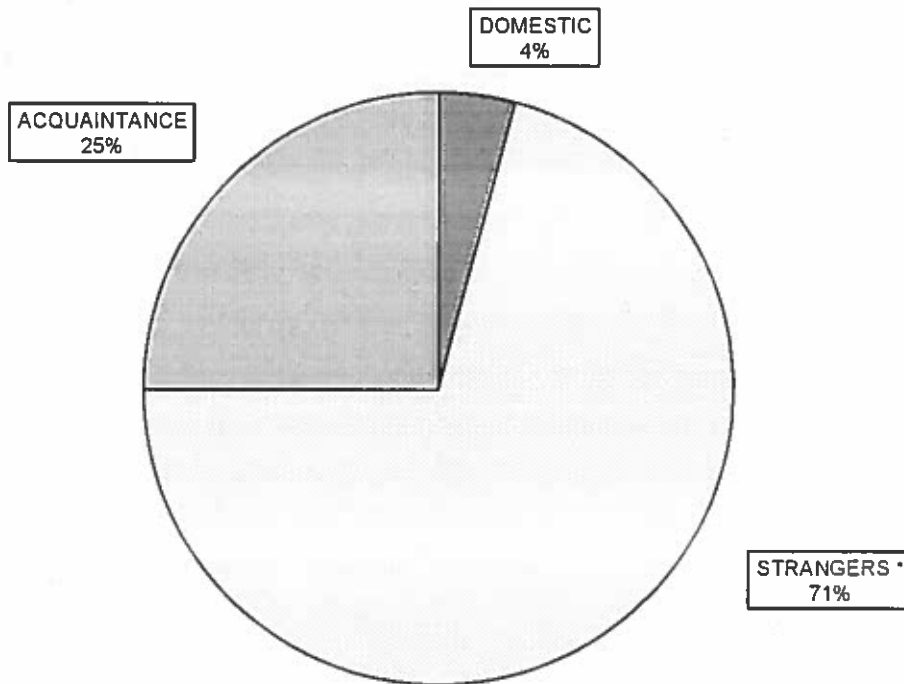

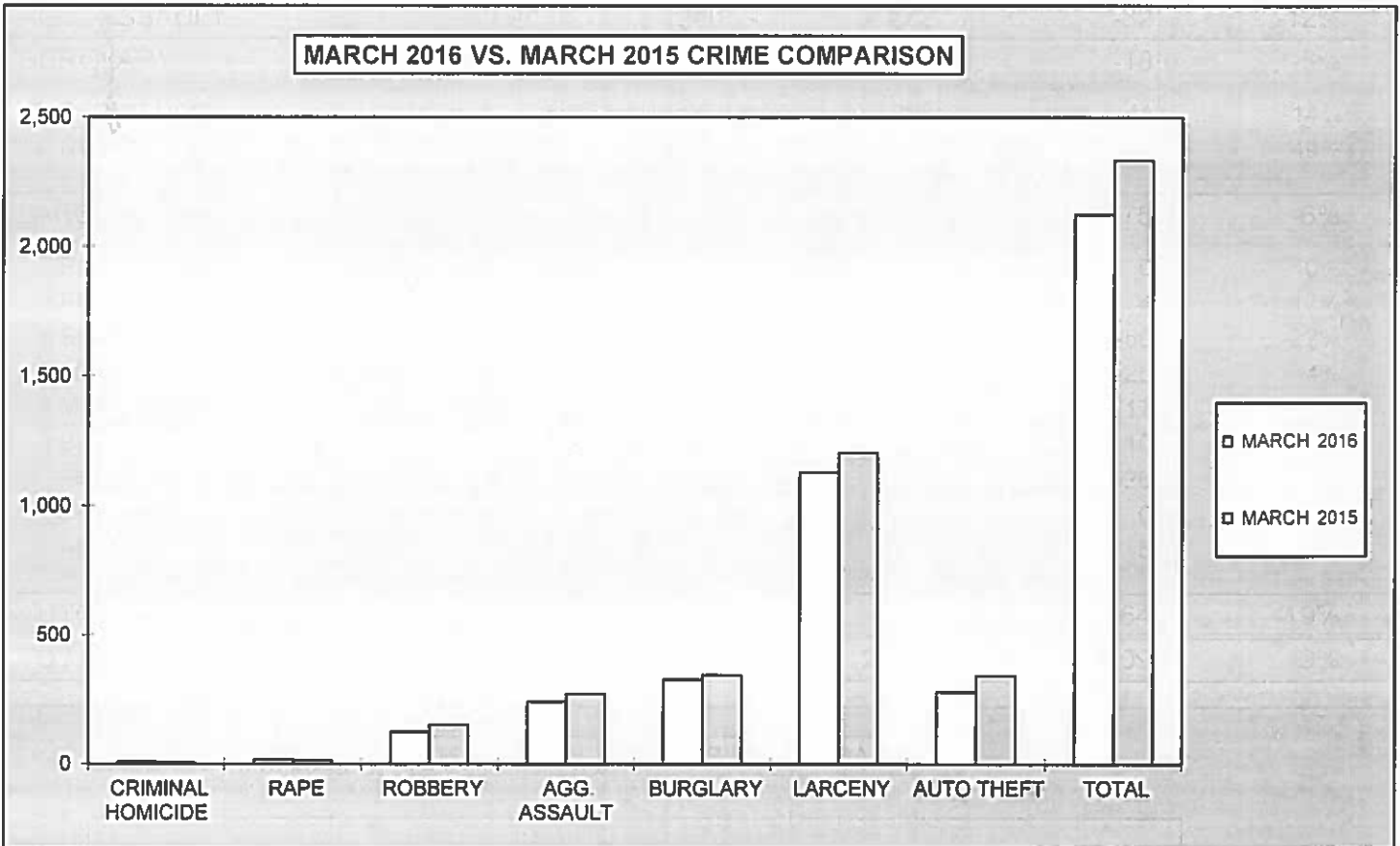
HOMICIDE BREAKDOWN BY VICTIM/OFFENDER RELATIONSHIP

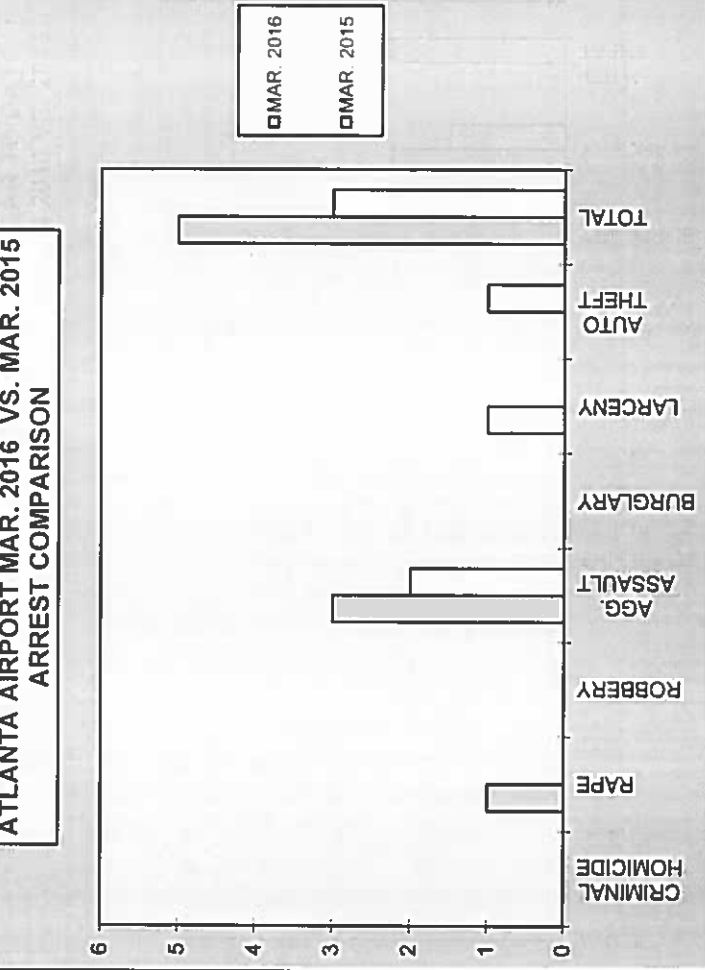

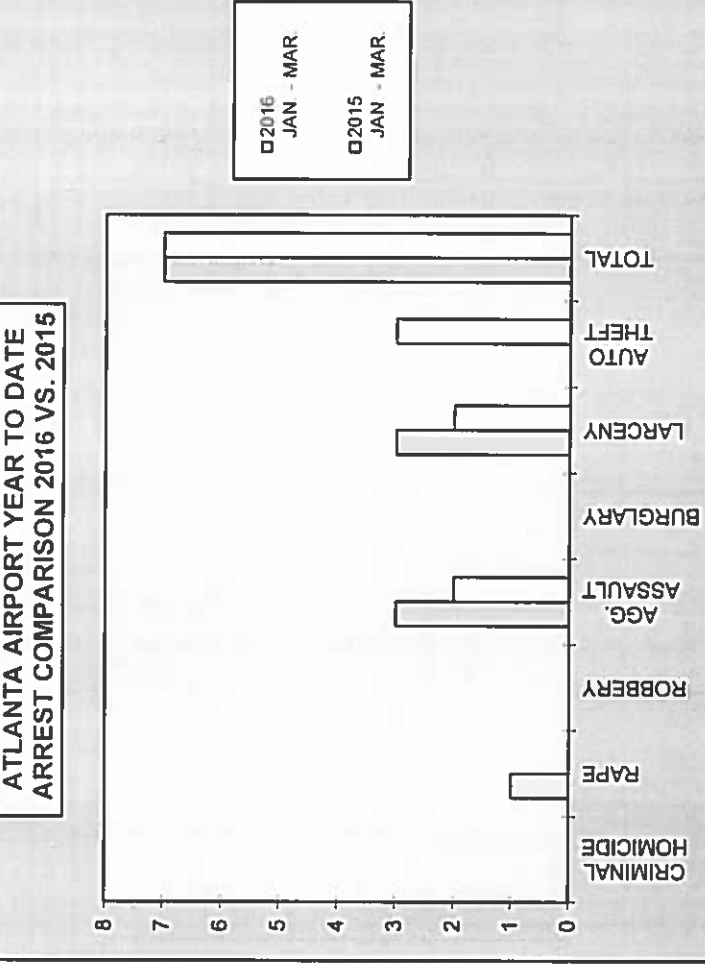
ATLANTA AIRPORT MAR. 2016 VS. MAR. 2015
