



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
# **Citizen vs Internal Complaints**




# **Closed Investigations vs Open Investigations**




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#### **DISPOSITIONS**



#### Disposition Legend:

Exceptionally Closed: Reasons outside the Department's control prevent it from continuing or completing its investigation of a complaint, and/or from charging and prosecuting an accused employee when sufficient evidence exists to charge the accused employee. Examples may include: the employee resigns, dies, or is no longer employed by the Department.

**Exonerated**: The incident occurred but the employee's actions were justified, lawful, and proper.


 $\underline{\textbf{Not-Sustained}} : \textbf{There is insufficient evidence to sustain a finding that the employee committed the violation.}$ 

 $\underline{\textbf{Sustained:}} \ \textbf{The investigative file provides sufficient evidence to support the finding that the employee committed the violation.}$ 


<u>Unfounded</u>: Complainant admits to the false allegation, the charge is false or not factual, or the accused employee was not involved in the incident.

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# **Unauthorized Use Of Force**




# **Vehicle Accidents**
