ZONE 5 DECEMBER 2014 VS. DECEMBER 2013 CRIME COMPARISON



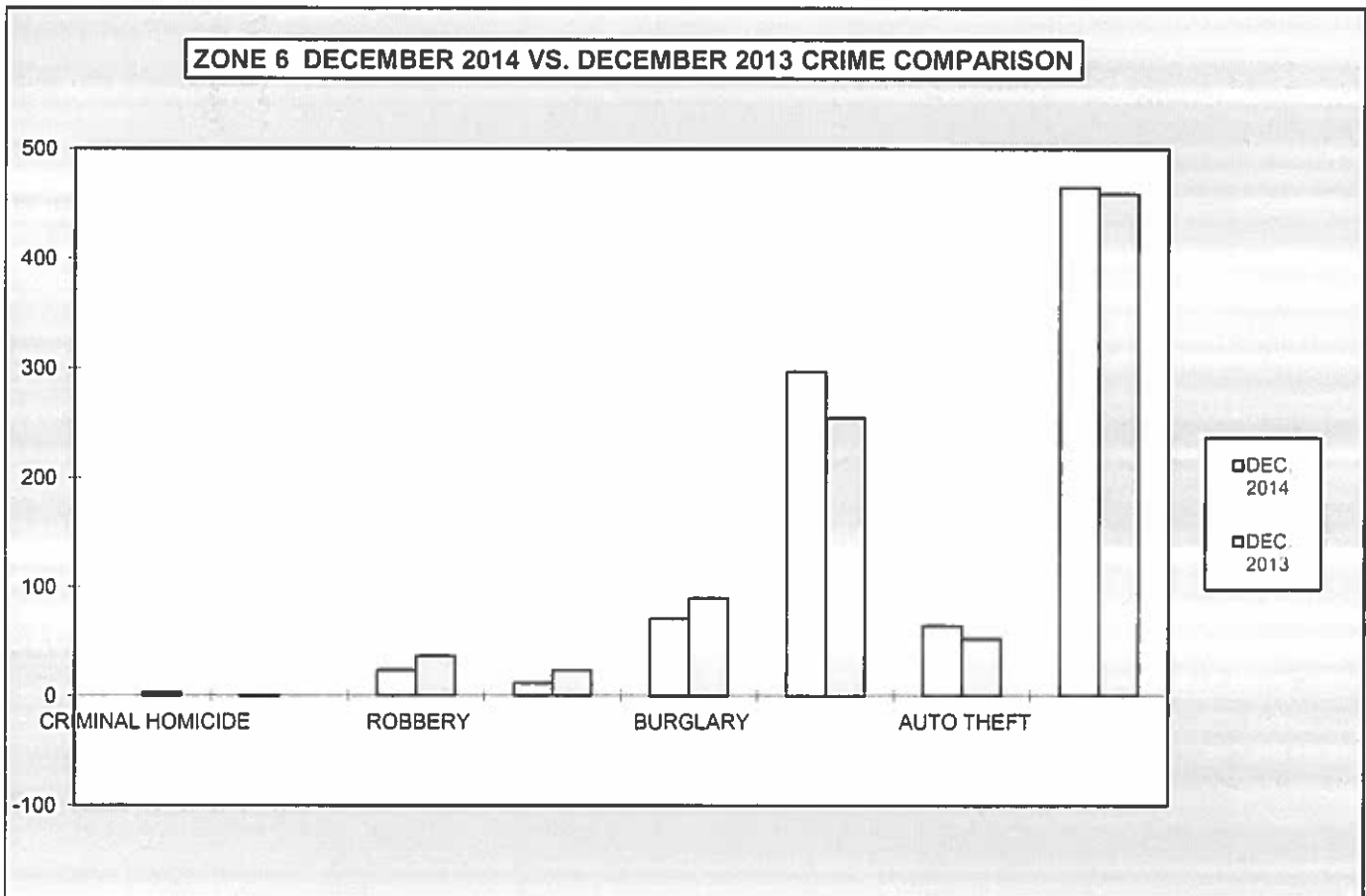
